

## Sweepstakes Rules

Sweepstakes are awarded to schools receiving the highest number of points. Points are earned for each event in which a student places 1<sup>st</sup> – 10<sup>th</sup>. So, it is a team effort to win sweepstakes!

Events have been put into 5 tiers and each place receives a different point value. Many individual events receive fewer points than group events requiring more “rehearsals”, coordination, difficulty, etc.

**\*These events are only at the Regional level and do not advance to State.**
